1. Preparing for studentlife

How you prepare before determines how well you lead students

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- Look out for and read your weekly communication
- Ask questions! If you have any questions about what's happening this week, your team leader and coordinators have great answers!

2. Before studentlife

The sooner you connect with students, the sooner relationships are built

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- Pray as soon as you park the car, so that you can get focused.
- Pick up your cheat sheet at the welcome center (*it's a packet of all your materials and important night-of information*).
- Supervise students and help make studentlife a safe place.

3. During a service at studentlife

Students look to their leaders for a cue to what is important

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- Sit with your students.
- Get into it!
- Take notes on the message.

4. In a studentlife group

God uses groups to provide a person to talk to, a place to belong, a purpose to live for.

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- Learn names.
- Use the material, but don't let it keep you from real organic conversation. Your questions are more powerful than you answers. *Conversation should be 20% leaders, 80% students.*
- Pray it out!
- Be real.
- Know their world so you can better help them apply their faith.

6. Beyond studentlife

If the relationship we want students to have with God goes beyond these four walls, then so should your relationship

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- You won't be able to all the time, but the best leaders try to text/reach out to each student individually!
- Attend service and make sure that you're growing as well as your students!

5. After studentlife

When we are proactively supervising students, we help studentlife to be a safe place

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- Proactively watch students to keep them safe.
- During pick-up is a good time to talk to an individual student about topics that might have come up in group.
- Try to talk to parents when they arrive to pick-up their students.
